### **Tata Main Hospital**

Tata Main Hospital is the iconic hospital of Tata Steel, established in 1908 catering to the needs of Tata Steel employees, their families, and the citizens of Jamshedpur. It is a 983-bedded hospital with all the basic and tertiary care facilities in eight super specialties i.e., Cardiology, Gastroenterology, Neurology, Neurology, Neurosurgery, Urology, Plastic Surgery and Surgical Oncology. This hospital also houses facility to conduct renal transplant and Bone Marrow Transplant. The hospital has been accredited for ISO 9001:2008 and now has NABH Progressive Level Certification. Our pathology laboratory is the first hospital based NABL accredited unit in Jharkhand.

Nursing training program in Tata Main Hospital started in 1939 and the students passed out of the School are literally present all over the globe. School of Nursing has been upgraded to a College from 2015 imparting Basic B.Sc. Nursing Degree. The course covers everything from best practices in routine care to intensive care to patient safety and patient care in various specialties. Our dream is to train nurses who will play a significant role in these cost-effective, higher technology, prevent and manage models.

# **Course Description**

Basic B.Sc. Nursing is four years (eighth semester) graduate program governed by Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi. The College is affiliated by Kolhan University. During the study, students learn about various medical subjects, social subjects and nursing subjects as per the syllabus prescribed by Indian Nursing Council. The medium of instruction and evaluation is English. Throughout the course, students gain clinical experiences at various units of Tata Main hospital and other hospitals for specialized areas such as psychiatry and oncology. Students also visit community setting at both rural and urban areas and participate in various projects under National Health Mission.

Annual examination is conducted at completion of each semester by Kolhan University. On successful completion of course, Basic B.Sc. Nursing degree is conferred upon students from Kolhan University, Chaibasa.

# **Hostel Facilities**

This course is a residential one. All students are provided with well-furnished hostel accommodation. They should follow the rules and regulations of the hostel, a copy of which will be handed over to the candidates on admission. No electrical or electronic items are allowed. Use of mobiles are strictly prohibited during clinical, class hours and at night.

# Boarding

An arrangement of common mess is available and payment on monthly basis on actual cost quoted by the service provider is to be paid by the student directly. The menu is pre-fixed. No cooked food from outside is permitted inside the hostel.

## **Annual Leave**

All students are entitled for 3 weeks of vacation in a staggered manner in each semester which they can avail according to the discretion of the managing authority of the College. All students are entitled for 15 institutional holidays in a calendar year.

# Sick Leave

Student nurse is not entitled for any sick leave during study period as per Indian Nursing Council regulations. However, for any medical reasons, students will be allowed leave on certification by an authorized medical practitioner of Tata Main Hospital. Sickness certified other than Tata Main Hospital will be treated as absenteeism. Sick leave beyond 7 days will be adjusted against their annual leave.

# Eligibility Criteria for Basic B. Sc. (N) Program

- Female and unmarried.
- The minimum age for admission shall be 17 years on 31st December of the year in which admission is sought
- The maximum age of admission shall be 25 years as on 31<sup>st</sup> December of the year in which admission is sought. Relaxed for SC/ST/other backward classes as per Govt. norm.
- Minimum education:

10+2 class passed in the subjects of PCB and English individually and must have obtained 45% marks in PCB i.e. Physics, Chemistry and Biology from recognized board under AISSCE/CBSE/ICSE/SSCE/HSCE/NIOS or other equivalent board. In case of SC/ST or other backward classes, qualifying marks in PCB is 40%.

• Student shall be medically fit as declared by physician in TMH.

# **Selection Procedure**

- All eligible candidates will be called for a written test conducted by competent authority. The venue and dates are informed after application submission.
- Candidates securing 50 % marks in entrance test will be shortlisted for personal interview.
- The selected candidates will be offered to join the programme subject to their being found medically fit from TMH.
- Candidates called for written test /interview will not be paid any allowances.

# Please note:

# Registration

On completion of Basic B.Sc. Nursing program, all student nurses must register themselves in the State Nursing Council as Registered Nurse & Midwife (RNRM).

# No Employment

No employment is guaranteed on completion of the Basic B.Sc. Nursing program at Tata Main Hospital. All the student nurses should note that training is imparted to each student for issuing a valid Degree Certificate from Kolhan University, Chaibasa and a Registration Certificate by Jharkhand Nurses Registration Council, Ranchi.
